I am writing to inform you that I am withdrawing all my funds from your institution and closing my accounts. I will work tirelessly to convince others to join me in doing so until your institution ceases to invest in EQT Midstream Partners (EQM), the primary corporation behind the proposed Mountain Valley Pipeline, LLC.

I refuse to be a silent participant in your decision to support the destructive fossil fuel economy in general and the Mountain Valley Pipeline (MVP) in particular. The MVP threatens air and water quality across Virginia and West Virginia, and violates the property rights of thousands of individual landowners. I strongly encourage you to broaden the service, care and integrity you reserve for your customers, shareholders, and employees to include your decisions about investments. When investment decisions affect our climate, we are all stakeholders. Where investment decisions affect drinking water, the communities of greatest importance are those who are impacted. We must choose to value our survival which means that the value of our planet's survival must be considered paramount.

You will not use my money to fund fracked gas pipelines that our communities, climate and planet cannot afford. I will call on neighbors, elected officials, and pension managers to close all accounts with your banks unless you immediately stop financing fracked gas pipelines and companies like EQM, which is in the sole business of building them.

I am satisfied with the service I have received from your institution and I would welcome the opportunity to return as a customer. When your actions reflect a standard of integrity that acknowledges the true impact of a financial institution on the state of our planet and the people, please let me know.
