Dear FERC Staff,

Please Stop Work on MVP. Stop cutting trees, stop the eminent domain of private land in the MVP case, stop construction of MVP. Deny MVP the right to proceed until they can prove a need in our Country. Deny MVP a construction permit on the grounds of insufficient information, inadequate and inaccurate information and out-and-out false information. Deny the MVP to proceed. The FERC needs to have a re-hearing of the MVP documents (after MVP cleans up their documents, puts them in order and performs further evaluation of the route and real avoidance and real costs to the soils involved and not just talk mitigation. Mitigation costs a lot more than avoidance. Detailed, boots on the ground evaluations need to be performed with an Order 1 Soil Survey (according to NRCS standards Form 232) before a route can be chosen. The land chosen for the route is unsuitable for MVP's proposed project, according to NRCS (Natural Resource Conservation Service) standards, which is what MVP put in their documents! Stop construction activities and tree clearing until a re-hearing. Deny MVP a construction permit.
