On October 13, 2017, the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission issued an order granting a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to Mountain Valley Pipeline, LLC.

In this filing, Mountain Valley requests two variances:

- Variance Request No. G-1: Add laydown yard LY-037; and
- Variance Request No. Bradshaw-1: 24-hour operations at the Bradshaw Compressor Station through May 31, 2018 to complete grading and site-preparation activities.
